is complainant and the aforesaid widow and heirs of Robert
Mosely Dec^d are Defendants the said widow and heirs by
said Commissioners do by these presents bargain sell convey
and confirm to the said Flowers his heirs and assigns
forever the tract or parcel of Land on the ^{day and} above mentioned
which is described as followeth To wit Begone A certain tract
or parcel of Land lying on the waters of Red River and
bounded as follows ^(beginning) Beginning at a black jack near a road
running thence North 84 East 190 poles to the same black jack

of Stone thence South 82 West 112 poles to some sapling marked
 thence South 13 E 114 poles to a stump near the Spring thence S 27
 W 66 poles to three hickory saplings near Hinton fence thence S 26
 E 110 poles to the Beginning containing 29 Acres
 To Anne and To Hold the before described tract or parcel
 of Land with its appurtenances to the said James R. Flowers
 his heirs and assigns forever free free from the claim or claim
 of all and every person or persons whatever claiming or to
 claim the same or any part or parcel thereof in any way
 or manner whatever the said Widow and Heirs of Robert
 Mosely Dec^d by said Commissioners will by their presents
 warrant and forever defend the Testimony of which the said
 Widow and heirs by said Commissioners hereto set their names
 and seals the date first herein written
